It's hard for me to believe it's time for another monthly update when it seems like I just wrote the last one. However, there's plenty to update about.



Since I last wrote, **we've done some street witnessing in the neighborhood where we hold our weekly services.** We gave out tracts and fake US money that had the Gospel written on the back in Spanish, as well as the name of our church with a phone number and e-mail address on it. The first Sunday morning we went with some people in our fellowship—some for their first time evangelizing—and saw the opportunity to pray with numerous people who needed healing in their bodies, including a man with A.I.D.S. He first asked us for prayer for his lungs because he didn't have enough money to replenish his puffer. We prayed with him until he assured us he was breathing better and gave him money to buy a refill.

The following week we joined a local pastor and a YWAM team from Brazil. With them we gave out more of our tracts. The team put on skits and children's dramas in the park for the numerous children there, and we saw one child give his heart to Christ that Saturday morning. Glory to God! In total between the two weekends we probably gave out between 800-1000 tracts with our church info on it.

Meetings with Centro de Fuego, our church, are going extremely well. We're averaging over 20-25 adults per week, and beginning to find the meetings to be a tight fit in the small boardroom we meet in. This is good, because we only have this room until August anyway. We are believing for God to provide a more suitable location of our own, and covet your **prayers about this, as we are currently searching for such a place and the funds to do it.**

In preparation for **the leaders' conference we're hosting this August 13th-15th,** I've been accompanying Ron Smith to meetings with fraternities of pastors and other situations where he describes our vision and invites people to come. He shows them the Derek Prince books the attendees will be receiving. This has resulted in numerous speaking engagements I've accompanied Ron to.

Recently we went to a church for our first time and Ron preached on the fire of God and living holy. During the altar time we saw one

person commit their life to Christ. Then we followed that with an altar call for people to receive physical healing in their bodies. I would say there were **nearly 30 people who came forward, we prayed and laid hands on people for various things from stomach pains, infections, and tumors.** Afterwards, we had several people come up to us to explain the difference they felt, the pain they realized was gone as a result of when we were praying for them. Some showed a noticeable physical difference since God touched them that night. Then as we were leaving, a man in the parking lot asked us to pray for him because he was too embarrassed to go forward and have people think something was wrong with him. **It turns out he had polio and one leg slightly shorter than the other....until he let us pray for him—and God healed him too! So awesome!**

This month I saw a significant dip in finances, so I've had more time to do other ministry related things with Ron. But I'm hoping to resume my Spanish classes for the entire month of July. One of the recent activities I had the pleasure of being involved in, was to go to one of my Peruvian friends' English classes in Central Lima. **Five classes had us come in and answer questions for about 15 minutes per class.** The classes ranged from basic level to advanced, and I must say I had a *lot* of fun. The teachers were very pleased about it. Upon finding out I actually live in Lima and was not just visiting, they have asked us to come back on a semi-regular basis. They would like us to also prepare games and activities next time.



In closing, I ask for prayer for our leaders' conference in August. Logistically, this will be the last letter of mine you'll receive before it takes place. There are at least 14 people confirmed to be coming, including students from the *F.I.R.E. School* in North Carolina, and some missionary couples ministering in Mexico, as well as our missions' director and his wife. **We're expecting God to do big things in both uniting upwards of 1000 leaders and pastors from throughout the country, and seeing the presence and fire of God impact them mightily.** If you listen to the *Fire On Your Head* Podcast, you can hear me describe our expectations during the update portions of recent episodes.

Thank you very much for your prayers, encouragement, and support. Your friendship is and has been very valuable to me.
