

be the equivalent of \$3/month tuition. I taught on building up the inner man, and saw 5 people come forward to be filled with the Holy Spirit—one of them being the taxi driver who took me and my interpreter there. He was as excited--if not more than the students were to receive!

In my last newsletter I mentioned a few things that almost immediately changed after my newsletter went to print. Ron Smith informed me that as of yet there's been no communication with the ministry in Iquitos that wanted to put on a conference in May. So far I'm assuming we're probably not going after all, but instead an opportunity to go to Ecuador has come up. It's possible to fly cheap, but accommodations are not factored into my monthly budget (which I'm trying to increase). So please pray for the ability to accompany Ron on this trip.

Another detail previously mentioned that's changed: our official Bible School won't be starting up until June due to circumstances that have come up, timing of a few things in our ministry, and in order to be better prepared when we launch, as well as the fact we don't have a suitable location locked in place at this time that could meet our needs.
