



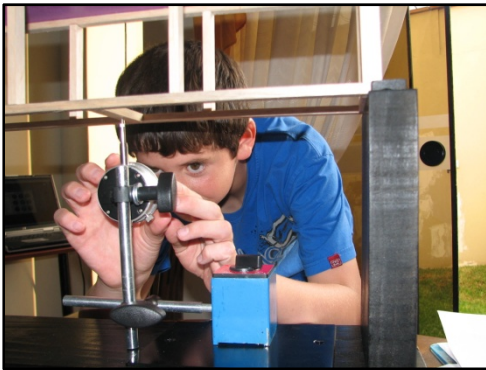
## Bible School begins
